### **ACTIVITY #6**

#### **Oh, No 99!**

Card Values: Aces (+ 1), Jacks ( - 10), Queens (wild card), Kings (+0)

All other cards (2 to 10) are worth their face value

Directions:

Shuffle the cards and deal four cards to each player. The undealt cards are placed in a stack, face down.

Players take turns playing one card at a time, adding or subtracting the value of their card to or from their jointly accumulating score.

Each time a player plays a card, he or she must replace it with the top card on the face-down stack.

Play continues until one player forces his/her opponent to go over a score of 99.

### **ACTIVITY #7**

#### **I SPY SUMS**

- Arrange the cards in rows.
- Player 1 secretly chooses two neighbouring cards and adds them together.
- Player 1 then says "I spy with my little eye, two cards with the sum of \_\_\_\_\_".
- Player 2 finds and picks up the neighbouring pair or pairs of cards with the correct sum.
- If Player 2 misses any other pairs with that sum, Player 1 can claim them.

The player with the most cards wins. **OR Play Addition Battle (see previous weeks lessons)**

### **ACTIVITY #8**

#### **Muffin Tin Coin Counting**
